# Warszawskim szlakiem kultury

W ciągu ostatnich lat Polska znalazła się na pierwszym miejscu wśród państw Unii Europejskiej pod względem wykorzystania środków finansowych przeznaczonych na kulturę. To właśnie ten sektor polskiej gospodarki okazał się jednym z najlepiej przygotowanych na zagospodarowanie funduszy unijnych. Środki europejskie pozwoliły na realizację wielu ambitnych projektów, które w istotny sposób wzbogacą mapę kulturalną Polski. Fundusze zostały przeznaczone na budowę i rozbudowę budynków mieszczących zarówno instytucje kultury – sale koncertowe, teatry, biblioteki, jak i szkoły oraz uczelnie artystyczne. Dzięki nim możliwa stała się realizacja wielu projektów z zakresu ochrony dziedzictwa narodowego. Renowacji poddane zostały zabytki architektury, piśmiennictwa i filmu. Realizacja inwestycji w kulturze była możliwa m.in. przy udziale środków z Programu Operacyjnego „Infrastruktura i Środowisko” oraz Mechanizmu Finansowego Europejskiego Obszaru Gospodarczego i Norweskiego Mechanizmu Finansowego. To dzięki nim dofinansowano aż 91 projektów infrastrukturalnych w całej Polsce na łączną kwotę niemal 4 mld zł (w tym ze środków europejskich na kwotę przeszło 2,3 mld zł). 20 projektów inwestycyjnych dofinansowanych ze środków europejskich realizowanych jest w Warszawie. Zachęcam Państwa do wycieczki po stolicy szlakiem dofinansowanych projektów.

## Investments in Culture Warsaw Cultural Route

During the last couple of years Poland found itself at the first place among the other European Union countries considering the use of the financial resources assigned to culture. It was the one sector of the Polish economy that appeared to be best prepared to make use of the Union's funds.

The European resources have allowed Poland to accomplish many ambitious projects, which will significantly enrich the Polish cultural map. The funds were assigned to build and extend the buildings hosting both institutions of culture – concert halls, theaters, libraries as well as schools and academies of art. Thanks to the gained resources, it was possible to realize many projects from the range of preservation of national heritage, what eventually resulted in the renewal of many monuments of architecture, writing and film.

The accomplishment of the investments in culture was possible due to participation of resources from the Operational Programme ‘Infrastructure and Environment’ and the European Financial Mechanism of the Economic District and the Norwegian Financial Mechanism. Those programmes made it possible for 91 projects scattered all over Poland to have been aided financially to the total amount of almost 4 billion PLN (where the European resources constituted over 2,3 billion PLN).

20 investment projects, partly financed by European resources, are realized in Warsaw. Herewith we encourage you to take a walk around the capital city following the trail of the aided projects.
